



**CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT
SEWAGE PUMPING STATION NO. 3**

NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION

The Town of Parry Sound has undertaken a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) Study to identify the preferred alternative for upgrading Sewage Pumping Station No. 3, located on the east side of Hawthorne Crescent. The Study has been carried out in accordance with the planning and design process for a Schedule B project as outlined in the Municipal Engineers Association *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* document.

The preferred alternative is to construct a new sewage pumping station to replace the existing station.

If concerns arise regarding this project that cannot be resolved in discussion with the Town of Parry Sound, a person or party may request that the Minister of Environment, Conservation and Parks make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the *Environmental Assessment Act* (referred to as a Part II Order), which addresses individual environmental assessments. Requests for a Part II Order must be received by the Minister within 30 calendar days of the date of this Notice at the address listed below.
